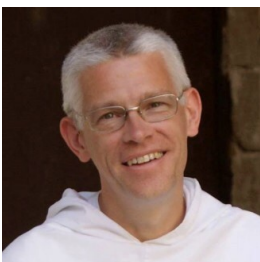

Psychotherapist and Supervisor, Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts. Former member of the National Catholic Safeguarding Commission.



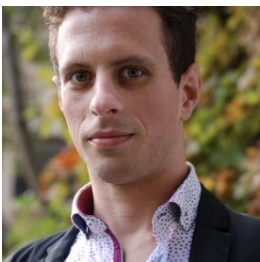

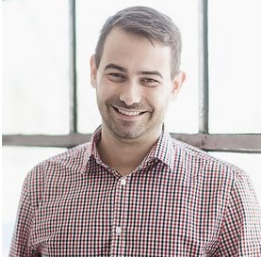
